HOTEL ART

Add another name to South Florida's growing list of hotels with curated art collections. Epic Residences & Hotel in downtown Miami has unveiled a \$2 million, 94-piece collection that includes sculpture, photography and paintings by a slate of international artists.

The collection was curated by Wynwood-based gallery owner **Diana Lowenstein** and her daughter **Flavia Lowenstein-Elortegui** to complement the design aesthetic of the waterfront building at 300 Biscayne Boulevard Way. Guests are greeted as they enter Epic by *Constant Chain*, a large bronze-in-white-patina sculpture of interlocking links by Polish artist **Xawery Wolski**. Other featured artists include **James Brown**, **Roberto Matta**, **Dario Basso**, **Fernando DeSzyszlo**, **José Bechara**, **Karina Wisniewska**, **Alexis Gorodine**, **Gye Hoon Park**, and **Ola Kolehmainen**.
